School Uniform & PE Kit

It has been a lovely start to the new academic year. The children have settled quickly into their routines and the majority of pupils are wearing school uniform.

Our uniform requirements are basic and we try to make it as cheap for parents as possible. T-shirts and sweatshirts with the school logo can be purchased from the school office but we also accept a plain jade green or white t-shirt and a red sweatshirt, available from the many supermarkets around our area. We ask that shoes are sensible and dark in colour.

It is essential that children have a PE kit in school at all times. PE forms part of the National Curriculum and it is essential that children are able to access this physical activity in clothing that is appropriate for the job.

PE kit should be named and be in a PE bag which can be hung from a cloakroom peg. It can be left at school for the entire half term. We can sometimes provide spare kit but we are very limited and children do not like wearing someone's cast off clothing!
